Part time students will also be involved in our performances and concerts whether it be behind the scenes or on the stage. They will learn the day to day running of a dance school and work closely with our professional team.

It is our commitment to you to provide you with the best possible training and preparation for your career as a dancer or dance teacher.

Part Time Student Expectations

As we will be committed to you and developing your career, we expect the same in return. Our part time students will be expected to show a dedicated work ethic and approach all tasks with enthusiasm. There will be some written work, research and project management as part of the course. This will enable everyone to open their minds and explore their creative side.

Students are expected to attend a minimum of five classes per week and a private tuition session with our Director. Students are expected to present themselves in a professional and tidy manner at all times.

Tuition Costs

Part time Course fees: \$800.00 per 10 week term

This includes unlimited technique classes, weekly industry class and one 30 minute training session with the course Director per week.
